

## ORDINANCE 2023-18

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 99.28 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CLAREMORE REGARDING DUCK BLINDS

**WHEREAS**, the City of Claremore, pursuant to the powers delegated to it by the Oklahoma Constitution, Oklahoma Statutes and as a Charter City, has the authority to establish regulations at Claremore Lake.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Claremore, Oklahoma, that:

<u>Section No. 1:</u> Amendment Section 99.28 of the City of Claremore Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (all deletions are struck through and all insertions are underlined):

## § 99.28 DUCK BLINDS; RENTING AND PRIVATE.

Duck hunting is allowed on Lake Claremore from stationary blinds as designated by the city. The drawing for such blinds is held on the first <u>last Saturday of October September</u> each year. Blind fee and the hunting permit fee, if applicable, will be paid as set out on the fee memorandum issued by the City Manager. Hunting hours are from one-half hour before sunrise till 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. until sunset.

<u>Section No. 2:</u> The City Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published as required by law.
