In this presentation, you will learn about what a will is, how an advance directive can help you, who is responsible for your stuff after you pass away, and what does it mean to go into a probate process. This presentation can help you if you find yourself caring for another person who is unable to make decisions for themselves and will require additional care after your passing. This presentation is up to half an hour in length and will be presented by one of our trained disaster professionals.


Before A Disaster Strikes: Legal Tips to Help Your Disaster Recovery
