RE: Vegetative Debris Concerns

Mr. Feary,

The vegetative debris from the storm on May 25, 2024 has quickly become a fire hazard and risk to public safety and health. The large piles of debris continue to dry out and are much easier to ignite. The amount of debris in the area could spread quickly and be extremely hard to control should it ignite.

We have not issued burn permits since the storm and have prohibited the issuance of residential firework permits in order to reduce the chances of fire occurring. Anything we could do to reduce the fire load and risk to the community would be greatly appreciated. Continuing dry conditions will continue to contribute to the risk.
