



ORDINANCE NO. 2026- 01

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING THE PORTION OF JOHN STREET COMMENCING AT THE EAST BOUNDARY OF LOT 5 EXTENDED THENCE WEST TO THE CITY RESERVOIR, AND THE ALLEY LYING WEST OF LOT 10 IN BLOCK 1 OF STATE PREPARATORY ADDITION, ALL IN THE CITY OF CLAREMORE IN ROGERS COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

THE CITY OF CLAREMORE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City of Claremore deems it necessary and expedient to close John Street commencing at the east boundary of Lot 5 extended thence west to the city reservoir ("Vacated Street"), and to close the alley lying west of Lot 10 in Block 1 of State Preparatory Addition ("Vacated Alley").

Section 2. That the franchise holders, City of Claremore, COXCOM, LLC, Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a division of ONE Gas, Inc., Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, LLC dba AT&T Oklahoma, AT&T Enterprises, LLC fka AT&T Corp, and Cox Oklahoma Telcom, LLC or other persons having a special right or privilege granted by ordinance or legislative enactment to use the Vacated Street and Vacated Alley have either consented in writing or have not otherwise objected to the closing. There are no other franchise holders or other persons having a special right or privilege to use such Vacated Street or Vacated Alley.

Section 3. The Vacated Street and Vacated Alley were established on the original Plat of State Preparatory Addition to the City of Claremore filed of record July 10, 1909, under Plat #025 (Document No. 1909-003794) at the Office of the Rogers County Clerk.

Section 4. John Street commencing at the east boundary of Lot 5 extended thence west to the city reservoir, and the alley lying west of Lot 10 in Block 1 of State Preparatory Addition all in the City of Claremore, in Rogers County, State of Oklahoma is hereby closed.

Section 5. Closing John Street commencing at the east boundary of Lot 5 extended thence west to the city reservoir, and the alley lying west of Lot 10 in Block 1 of State Preparatory Addition of the City of Claremore shall not affect the right to maintain, repair, reconstruct, operate or remove utility, public service corporation or transmission company facilities or service therein.

Section 6. In the judgment of the City Council of the City of Claremore, Oklahoma, the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Claremore, Oklahoma and the inhabitants thereof demand the immediate passage of this ordinance, an emergency is hereby declared, the rules are suspended, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect on its passage and approval.


