# **Camp Rules(2026)**

## **Liability Release Form:**

Parents, you will be required to sign a Liability Release Form for each of your children who are participating in camps sponsored by the City of Claremore. Children will not be able to participate in camps without this signed form on file.

## **Payment:**

Payment may be made with cash or personal check at the Claremore Park and Recreation Department, located within the Claremore Community Center (2301 N. Sioux). Sorry, but we do not have the ability to take on-line payments for the camps. All fees must be paid before the camp(s) begin. **We will not be receiving any camp payments at the door at check-in time.** Fees that are not paid in full before camps begin, will not be allowed to attend that camp. **Checks must be made out to the instructor of the camp that you are enrolling in only and not to the City of Claremore.**

## **Special Notice:**

Please let us know, at the time of enrollment, if your child might have any allergic reactions to any foods or materials that could present problems for them, while attending our camps.

## **Refund Policy:**

Full refunds will be granted if the request is submitted (7) business days in advance of the camp start date.

Once the camp has begun, no refunds will be granted. The instructor has already purchased all supplies for that camp.

## **Please Note:**

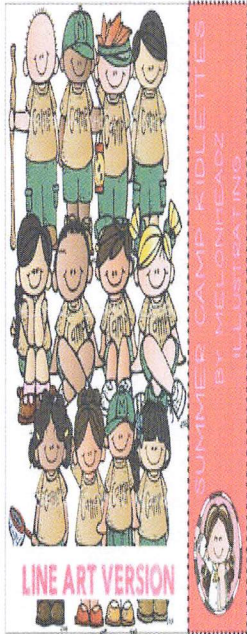
